**GUNDOG WORKING TEST SCHEDULE – SPRING 2012**

(held under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations)

**VENUE:** Novar Estate Evanton, Ross-shire  
**DATE:** Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> March 2012  
**TIME:** 10 am  
**JUDGES:** Retrievers – Mr J Munro (A1898); Mr I Sutherland (NP); Mr M Brown (NP)  
Spaniels – Mr S Waddell (A2388); other TBA

**ENTRY FORMS:** Entries to be made on the day only.

**ENTRY FEES:** pups £5, novice and open £6 per stake.

**TESTS:**

PUPPY – dogs under 18 months on the date of the test

NOVICE – confined to dogs which have not gained an award or certificate of merit at a field trial, has been placed 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in an open gundog working test or 1<sup>st</sup> in a novice gundog working test.

OPEN- no restrictions

**Directions to Novar Estate**

**From the South**

From Inverness, follow A9 north, over Kessock and Cromarty bridges.

Continue on A9, passing Storehouse of Foulis and then turn left on B817 to Evanton.

Continue through the village and then pass two yellow-painted cottages on the left.

Shortly after, turn left into the drive with gateposts and a small lodge house at the entrance (0.7 miles north of village). Travel straight up the drive to the farm mains at the top of the hill.

**From the North**

Travel south on A9 or B9176 (Struie Road) towards Evanton.

If on A9, turn right on B9176 then left on B817 signposted Evanton.

If on B9176, turn right on B817 signposted Evanton.

Pass Novar-Tulloch Timber and Fencing Supplies on right.

Shortly after, turn right into the drive with gateposts and a small lodge house at the entrance. Travel straight up the drive to the farm mains at the top of the hill.
